Sir,

I am to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the AICTE Task-Force constituted to assess the proposals for approval of new or on-going Post-graduate programmes, the Expert Committee which visited the institution and subsequent decision by the All India Board of Post Graduate Education in Engineering & Technology, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College, Ludhiana, Punjab to conduct the following PG Course(s), from the academic year 1996-97 :

Department	Specialization/ Degree	Annual Intake (General non-sponsored)	Full time/ Part time
Mechanical & Production Engg.	Industrial Engg. (M.E.) (Instead of proposed nomenclature "Industrial Engg. & Management")	10	Full-time

The approval given above is subject to the conditions given below:

- (1) Additional 5 (five) sponsored candidates can be admitted for the above PG programme.
- (2) No new PG courses in Engg /Tech /Arch /Planning /Pharm /Management /Applied Arts & Crafts shall be started by the Institution without prior approval of the AICTE.
- (3) The intake for the above course shall not be increased or decreased without the prior approval of the AICTE.

- (4) The reservations for SC/ST candidates etc. shall be over and above the intake, if such reservations are provided by the Institution as per State/Central Government's Policy.
- (5) No scholarships / any other financial assistance will be provided by the AICTE / MHRD for conduct of the above programme(s).
- (6) The following minimum facilities must be created before starting the programme(s) :
- Equipment : Minimum additional Rs.10.00 lacs should be spent for purchase of equipment relating to the area of the programme.
 - Faculty : One Professor and one Asst. Professor must be recruited for each specialised area of the Post Graduate programme, in addition to the other faculty available.
 - Visiting Faculty : A minimum of Rs.20,000/- must be spent for each programme in a year on visiting faculty from reputed institutions and the industries.
 - Library Books : At least Rs.10,000/- should be spent for each programme every year for purchase of books and/or subscription to reputed journals.
 - Computer facilities : There must be at least 10 additional terminals or five PCs for each area of specialisation.
- (7) The admission to the above PG Programme(s) should be made in accordance with the AICTE guidelines given as Annexure-I to this letter.

Sub : Rationalisation of Nomenclature for Bachelor Degree Course in Engineering & Technology.

Sir,

The All India Board of Undergraduate Education in its fourth meeting held on 22.12.95 has discussed the issue regarding rationalisation of nomenclature for Bachelor Degree course in Engineering & Technology, which is approved by Executive Committee Meeting of the Council held on 22.03.96.

The recommendations are as follows :

The Bachelor degree course in Engineering & Technology would be designated as one of the following :

(a) B.Sc.(Engg) (b) B.E. (c) B.Tech

2. The nomenclature of the discipline under the Bachelor degree programme in Engineering and Technology would be as suggested by Mr Chacko and also as modified by this Board (copy enclosed).

The Board recommended that the number of major disciplines should be kept to minimum possible and should discourage proliferation of nomenclature of major disciplines.

The illustrative specialisation could be used to describe the special contents of these disciplines. As per example shown in Chemical Engineering such as :

(Fuel & Combustion Technology)
 (Oils, soaps & detergents)
 (Paints)
 (Plastics)
 (Polymer Science)
 (Rubber Technology)
 (Pulp & Paper Technology)


This approval has been accorded subject to fulfillment of specific and general conditions as listed in Annexure I & II respectively. All other conditions mentioned in the council's earlier approval letter, remains unchanged.

The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 22.05.1994 Based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP(C) No. 467 of 1992 in the case of Jini Krishnan JP and other etc. V/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements. No Management/Institution/Trust or Society shall announce admissions directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision taken by the institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the conditions prescribed by the AICTE in December 1996. The Council shall take further action to withdraw approval to these cases for admission during 1997-98 and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions.

You are requested to kindly monitor the progress made by these institutions for fulfillment of conditions laid down in this approval and keep the North Western Regional Committee and AICTE informed.
